Re - KS3 National Curriculum (Adventurous Activities)
Glan Llyn - 17th - 21st May 2010

I am in the process of arranging a visit to the Urdd Camp at Glan Llyn, Bala, 17th - 21st May 2010. The cost of the five days will be £196. This price includes travel and insurance. During their stay at Glanllyn students will take part in the following activities: canoeing, climbing, sailing, swimming, walking and a variety of indoor games (weather permitting). This course will provide students with a wonderful opportunity and one which they will never forget.

Approximately 90 students in Year 7 will be able to take part in this visit to Bala. Good standards of behaviour and a sense of responsibility, which are important at all times, become more necessary when young people are away from home and school. As a school we have a very good record at Glanllyn. Groups of our students always receive high praise from the organisers. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT WE MAINTAIN THIS EXCELLENT REPUTATION. Please complete Form 'B' and return with the deposit and reply slip. Parents can claim remission for Board and Lodgings only if the claimant is on one of the following benefits.

1. Income support - We need proof from DHSS to include May 2010.
2. Income Based Job Seekers Allowance - We need proof from DHSS to include May 2010.
3. Working Tax Credit - We need to see Tax Credit Award Notice from Inland Revenue.
4. Child Tax Credit - As long as income is not over £13,480 - We need to see Tax Credit Award Notice from Inland Revenue.

Following payment of the initial deposit, which is non-returnable your child will be given a savings card. Please could the balance be paid on the following dates: -

£50 before 1st March
£50 before 12th April
£70 before 4th May

IMPORTANT. All deposits and form 'B' must be placed in a sealed envelope. Your child's name, form and title of trip must be on the front of the envelope. Envelopes are to be posted in the post box by the main entrance. Likewise all future payments must be placed in an envelope and placed in the post box.
